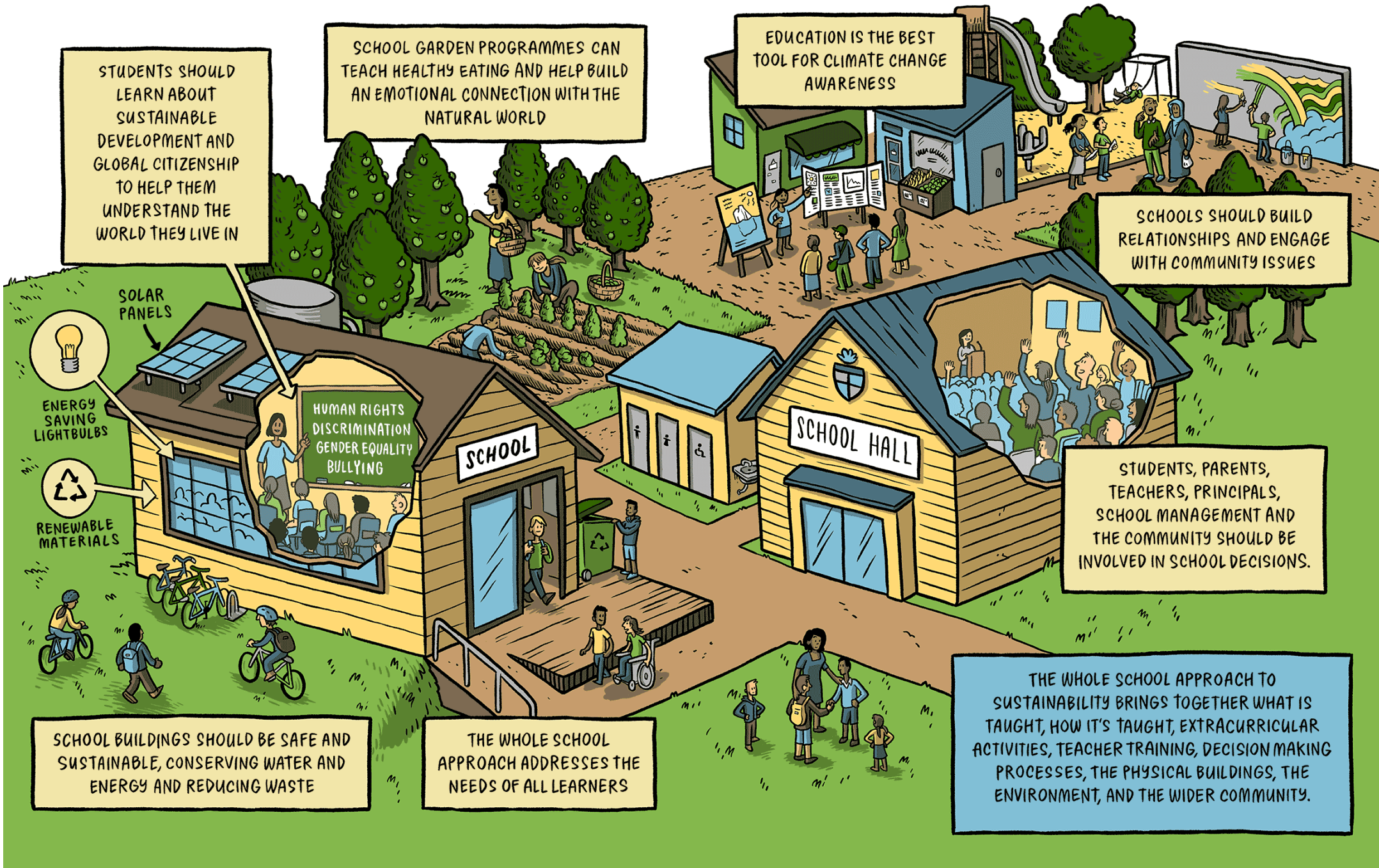


Sustainability is not just something to learn, it's something to live!
